## Canadian Patient Safety Officer Course to be held in September

CPSI will be holding the second Canadian Patient Safety Officer Course (CPSOC) this Fall. The CPSOC is a comprehensive safety course, including interactive workshops, case studies, team building activities with networking and coaching by patient safety leaders. The course should be of interest to healthcare professionals and leaders who have a formal responsibility for disseminating patient safety principles/programs throughout their organization and understand the fundamentals of patient safety.

When: September 21 to 26, 2008.

Where: Kingbridge Centre in King City (Toronto), Ontario.

Registration fee: \$6,300 (includes GST, the five-day program, meals and accommodations). Participants are required to cover their own travel expenses to and from the Centre.
